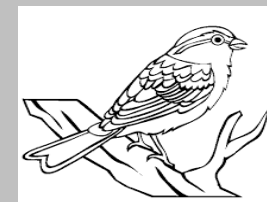

TREE FOR LIFE SCHEME WELCOMES APPLICATIONS FROM NEW PARENTS



A Tree for Life scheme in Mid Suffolk, which offers a free tree for new parents, is open for 2021 applications. The scheme is open to all families in the district who have or are welcoming a new arrival between 1 January and 31 December 2021.

The initiative offers parents with a new born or newly adopted child the chance to mark their arrival by planting a tree. It aims to benefit families, communities and the environment by boosting tree coverage across the district.

Parents who may have lost a child during the same period are also able to apply for a remembrance tree.

So far the council have given out over a thousand trees through Tree for Life, with 2020 applicants collecting their trees last month following a necessary delay to allow the council to prioritise essential services during the pandemic.

Expert help is always on hand on collection to advise families on their tree choice and aftercare at home.

Over 100 families have already applied to the 2021 scheme, but the council are encouraging even more people to apply for their tree on the council's website www.midsuffolk.gov.uk/environment/tree-for-life before the 10 January 2022 deadline.

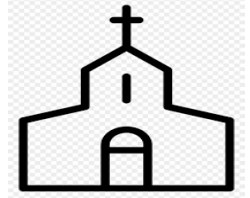
