
PLANNED MOTORCYCLE EVENTS AT WATTISFIELD HALL

VILLAGE POND MAKEOVER

The Parish Council are of the view that the village pond and surrounding land, which are owned by Mid Suffolk District Council, are in need of some love and care.

As a first stage, the Parish Council, with the support of the District Councillor Rick Meyer (who is also a Parish Councillor) and Mid Suffolk District Council, are arranging to have the pond dredged this summer which will then increase the depth and hopefully reduce the risk of it drying out during the summer months. The will improve the habitat for the wild life.

The Parish Council are also seeking guidance from Suffolk Wildlife Trust on the proposed dredging and possible enhancements to the surrounding area to support existing wildlife and to encourage new species.

This is very much a long term project but the dredging will be a first step.
