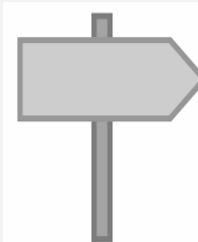

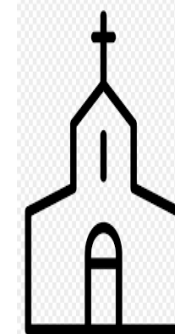

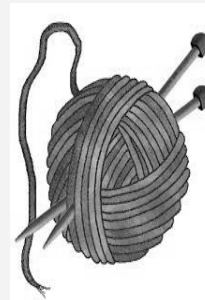
### CRAFTEA TIME
