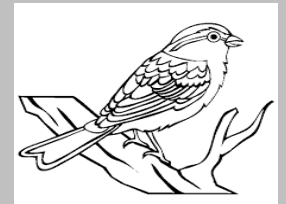

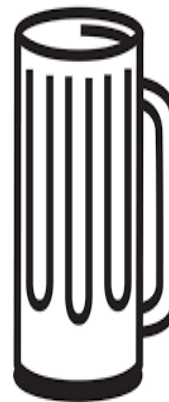

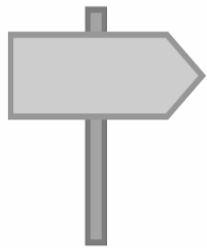

The trustees offer financial help to residents who have encountered unexpected expenses. This help is offered throughout the year and to young and old alike.

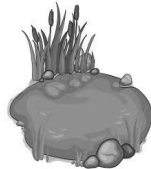
Many are currently going through tough times financially. If you or someone you know is in need of help, do please get in touch with the trustees who will consider your application in absolute confidence.

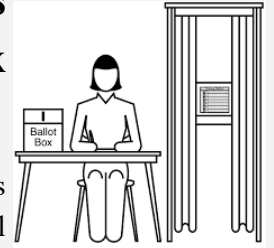
POND NEWS

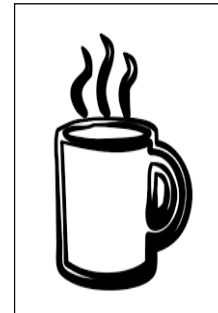


Don't Lose Your Vote – Residents Across The District Urged To Check Their Voter Registration Details
